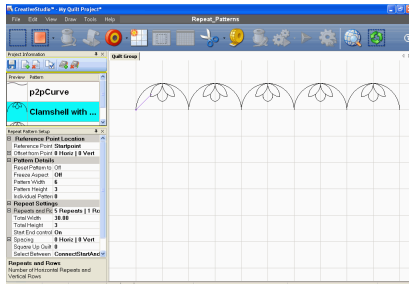
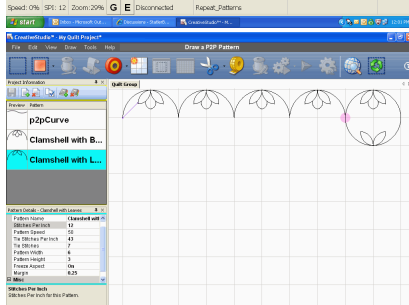


Clamshell Combinations

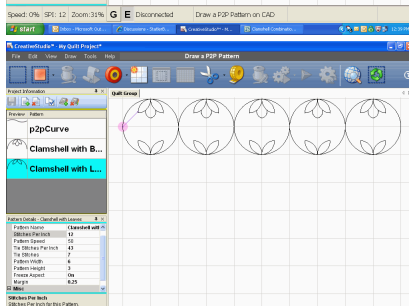

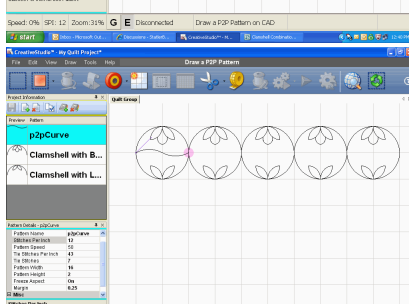
Choose a fancy clamshell and use Repeat Patterns to set a row of patterns to fill the length of your sashing, but only half of the desired total height.



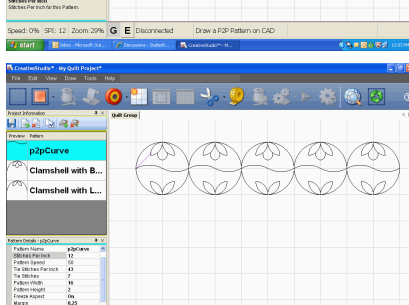
Select a second clamshell. Turn on End Snap. Use Draw Sewable Pattern and click from right to left to add the lower row of clamshells.



Top and bottom rows are now in place and ready to stitch, or you can go one step further.



If you like, select another P2P pattern to set in between the top and bottom rows. I chose PS P2P Curve. Use End Snap and click from left to right to set a curve inside each clamshell combo.
