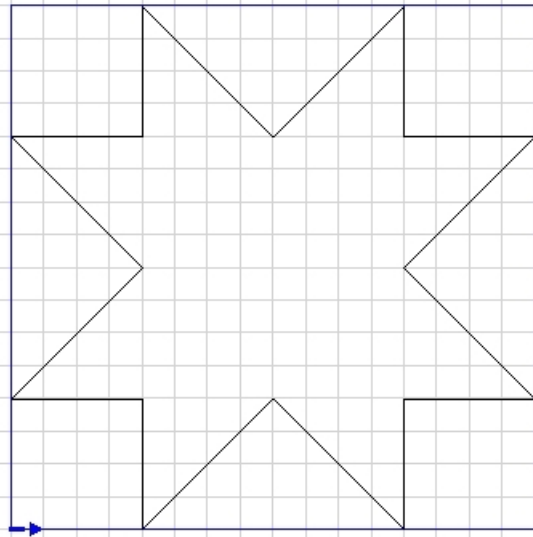


Using P2P T riangle Patterns to Fill Large Background Areas

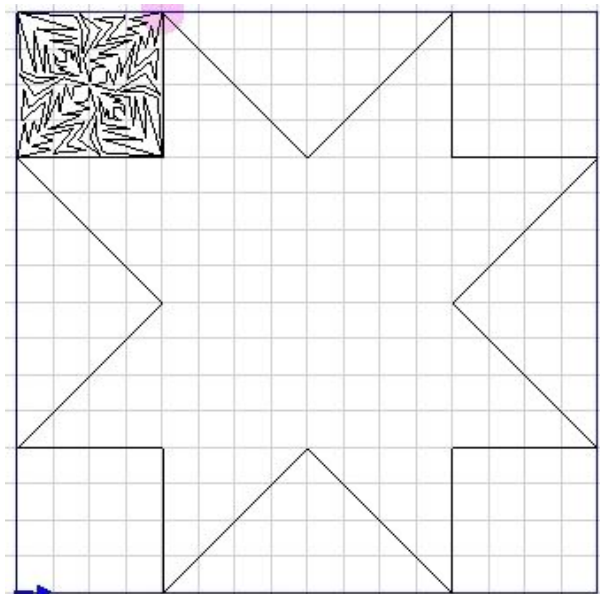
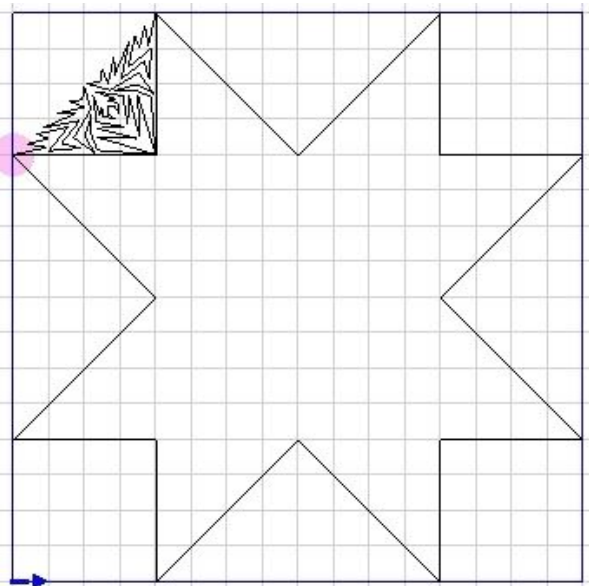

Both the squares and the triangles behind a large star quilt can be filled with P2P Triangle patterns. There is no need to use separate patterns for each space, and by following the steps below, the density of the quilting will remain the same in each area.

Choose a P2P Triangle pattern you like and select the Point to Point Pattern function on the tool bar. This pattern is called Electricity.

Begin by clicking across the corner background block on the diagonal, from UR to LL, then back again to the UR. These two triangles will fill the corner block.



The large background triangle can be filled with two P2P Triangle patterns by clicking down to the center point and back up the other side. Finish the second corner square by clicking on the diagonal from UL to LR and back to UL again.

If you click without stopping, all of the P2P patterns will be connected and they will stitch in a continuous line.

Fill the side triangles as you work your way down the quilt. Remember that the patterns along the bottom will need to be placed from R to L. Be sure to check the CAD screen for proper placement before you quilt.
